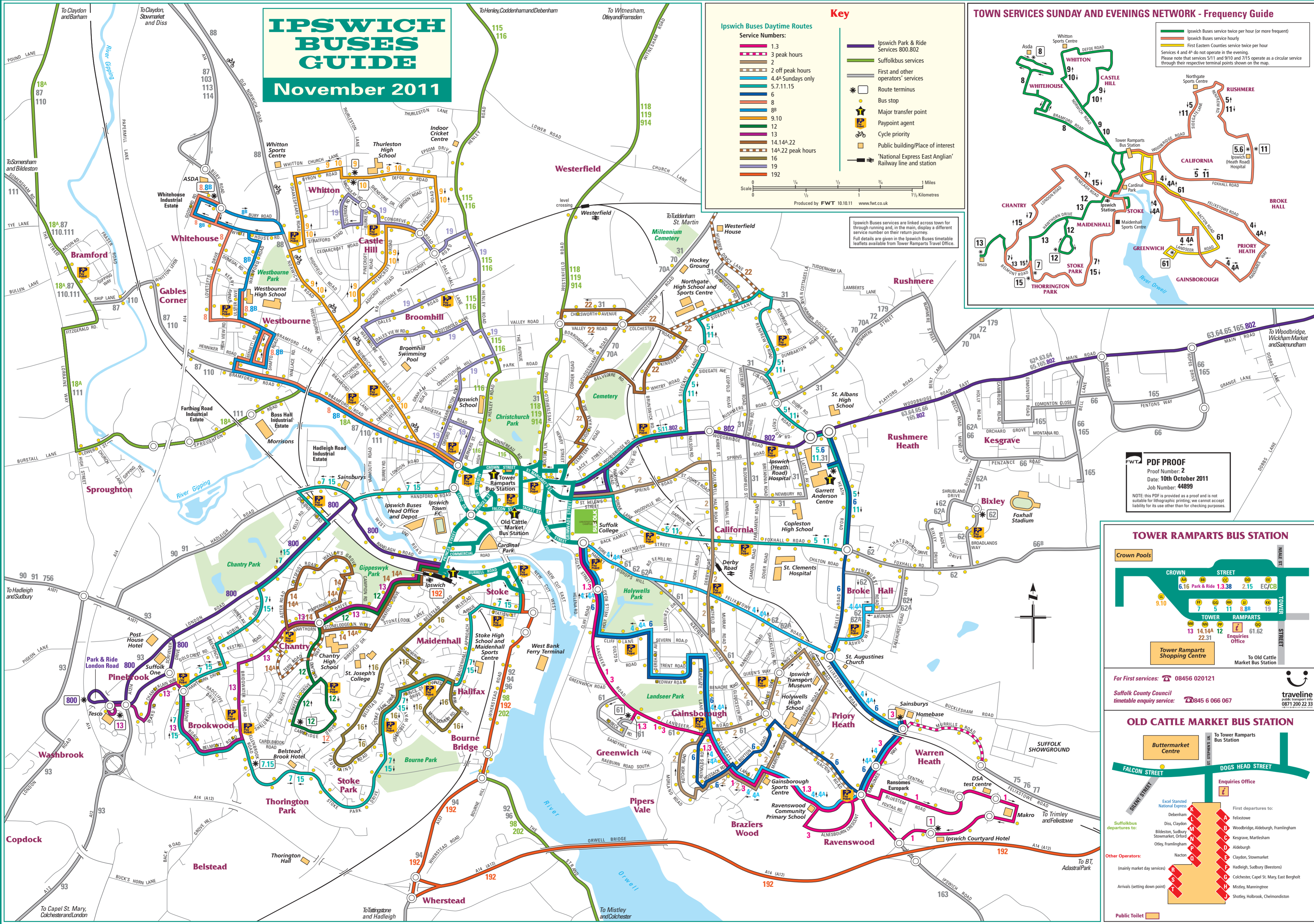

TOWN SERVICES SUNDAY AND EVENINGS NETWORK - Frequency Guide

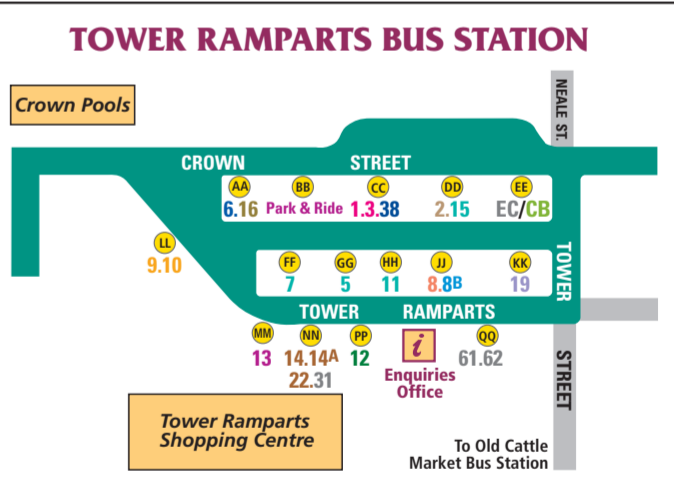
- Ipswich Buses service twice per hour (or more frequent)
